Cosmetic Product Regulation

The manufacture and supply of Cosmetic Products are regulated in the UK under Cosmetic Products Regulation.

A cosmetic product can be defined as any substance or preparation intended to be placed in contact with the various external parts of the human body, with a view to exclusively or mainly to cleaning them, perfuming them, changing their appearance, controlling body odours, protecting them or keeping them in good condition.

The manufacturer or supplier of the cosmetic product is responsible for ensuring it is safe for use. Each item must have a safety assessment prepared by a suitably qualified, professional person, before being made available for sale.

The ingredients have to be shown on the label according to the correct nomenclature and listed in descending order of inclusion level. The label must also include a name and address of a “responsible person”, printed on the label, from whom all the product information is available.

Only products which have undergone all the necessary procedures can be added to the Cosmetics Products Notification Portal (CPNP). As of the 11 July 2013 this is mandatory.

All the cosmetic products that Evans Vanodine manufacture and supply, including Pink Pearl, Orchard Fresh, Ocean Blue, Luxury Silk, Hand Lotion, Trigon, Trigon Foam Plus, Citrus Foam, Citrand, Vanagel and Care Hands Barrier Cream, are produced in accordance with the requirements of the Cosmetic Products Regulation and are suitable for sale throughout the European market.

Any company that manufactures cosmetic products must comply with the REGULATION (EC) No 1223/2009 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 30 November 2009 on cosmetic products; otherwise they are not allowed to sell them.
