Description

A ready to use thickened barrier iodophor teat dip, that has been specially formulated to help reduce the bacterial contamination that causes mastitis in dairy herds. It reduces the risk of infection by leaving a lasting thick antiseptic film of iodine clinging to the teats that have been dipped. Contains 9% Glycerol & Sorbitol to help keep teats soft & supple all year round & to aid in the prevention & healing of cracked & chapped teats. The thick clinging properties make it especially useful at times when teat condition is threatened by adverse weather conditions or strong bacterial challenge, e.g. muddy gateways & mucky passages.

How to Use

TEAT DIPPING:

Fill teat cup about $\frac{2}{3}$ full. No dilution is required. Dip teats of every cow immediately after each has been milked, making sure that the full length of the teat is immersed. Top up with fresh solution as required. Empty and wash out cups after milking. Dry teats before milking

Not suitable for spraying, due to viscous nature of the product.

Contains a blend of Iodine, Glycerol, Sorbitol & Nonionic Surfactant.
