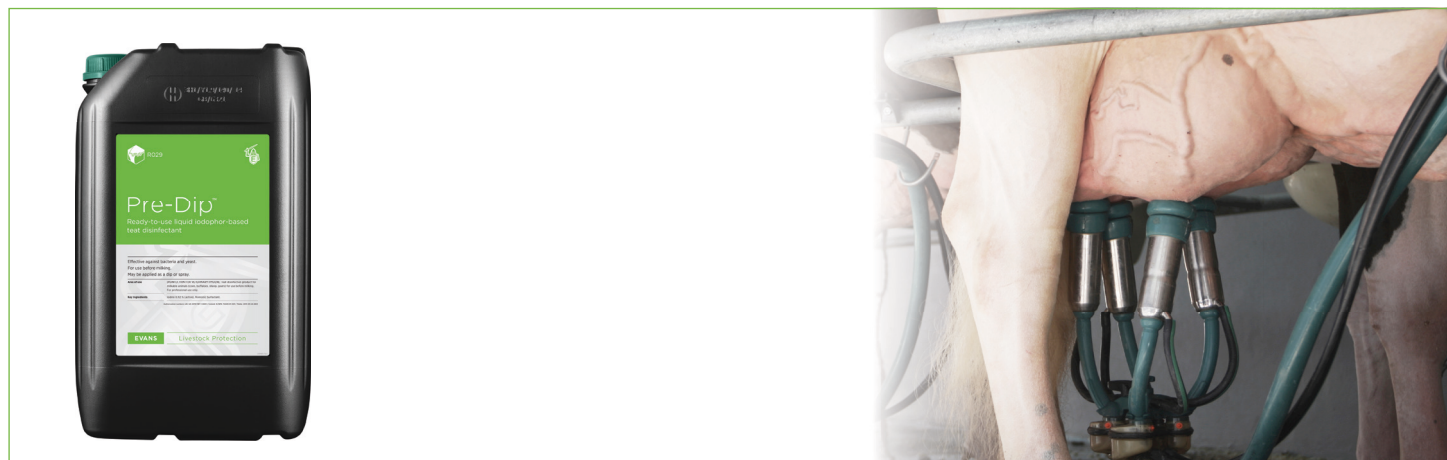


Pre-Dip™

Ready-to-use liquid iodophor-based pre-milking teat disinfectant



An iodophor based solution which should be used to prepare cows' teats before milking.

Cleans and disinfects the cows' teats and udder prior to milking.

Passes EN 1656. Helps to control the total bacteria count in the milk tank.

- Kills mastitis causing bacteria picked up from the environment.
- Fast acting and has strong bactericidal properties.
- Passes European disinfectant test method EN 1656 in 15 seconds.
- Tested in a UKAS Accredited Laboratory.
- Ready-to-use, especially suitable for situations where measurement and mixing are likely to prove inconvenient.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: This product must be brought to a temperature above 20°C before use. Use undiluted. The use of a dosing pump for filling application equipment is recommended. Ensure udder and teats are clean and dry before using this product. Apply before each milking every day (1-3 times a day). For manual application ensure the full teat is covered for a minimum contact time of 60 seconds.

MANUAL DIPPING:

Fill teat dip cup $\frac{2}{3}$ full with product. Dip the teats of each cow before milking, making sure that the full length of the teat is immersed. Allow at least 60 seconds contact time, then wipe and dry the teats thoroughly using a single use paper towel. Top up with fresh solution as required. Empty and wash out cups with water after use.

MANUAL SPRAYING USING AN ELECTRONIC SPRAYER:

Before milking, spray the entire surface of each teat of every cow with product. Ensure the spray covers the entire surface of all the teats. Leave the product on the teats for at least 60 seconds, then wipe and dry the teats thoroughly using a single use paper towel. After use, dispose of unused product, the packaging and any contaminated materials in accordance with local requirements. Used product can be flushed to the municipal sewer or disposed to the manure deposit depending on local requirements. Avoid release to an on-site waste water treatment plant.
