WHY IS HAND WASHING IMPORTANT?

Hand washing is one of the most important steps in reducing the risk of cross contamination in a healthcare environment.

Good hand hygiene helps to stop organisms from being transferred from one patient to another and can reduce the spread of infection.

Training is vitally important especially HOW? WHEN? and WHY? because by not washing hands when they should be, not washing them in the correct way or not drying them thoroughly can also mean there is still a risk of contamination.

Not washing hands correctly can also impact the economy, when people become ill and subsequently have to take time off work or children are unable to attend school. It also puts tremendous pressure on Doctors' surgeries and the National Health Service due to ill health.

CRITICAL CONTROL POINT

When working in a healthcare environment there are three important questions about hand hygiene:

HANDWASHING: WHEN? WITH WHAT? HOW?

When should I clean my hands during work?

The five moments approach for hand hygiene defines the key moments when healthcare workers should perform hand hygiene. The approach was developed by the World Health Organisation (WHO) and is used by the national cleanyourhands campaign to help everyone working in healthcare to decide when to clean their hands. The five moments are: before touching a patient, before clean/aseptic procedures, after body fluid exposure/risk, after touching a patient and after touching patients surroundings.

What should I use to clean my hands and how should I use it?

There are two things you can use to clean your hands: washing with soap and water, or you can use alcohol hand rub. Both are acceptable ways to clean your hands. It is important to make sure your hands are cleaned thoroughly to ensure acceptable decontamination is achieved.

How should I wash my hands?







KITCHEN STANDARDS - NHS GUIDELINES

These standards place responsibility on anyone using shared facilities to take all necessary measures to ensure the safety and cleanliness of a kitchen and/or ward pantry. (please see information from NHS guidelines manual). Wherever food or drinks are prepared, the highest standards of cleanliness and hygiene are essential.

In areas where hygiene is important, and with strict guidelines in place, it is vital that the cleaning products you use will meet all the necessary standards. Choosing the right product involves careful consideration of the type of product used for certain tasks and the impact on the environment.

Make sure the cleaning products you use pass the relevant EN test standards, be aware that any shared use patient crockery and cutlery must be cleaned using very high temperature water, a mechanical dishwasher is recommended for this process.



Dismantle the showerhead and place in a solution of 2 x 10ml caps EC9 to 5 litres of warm water. Leave to soak for 30 minutes. Agitation with a nylon scrubbing brush may be necessary to remove heavy soil and limescale.

DISINFECTION OF SHOWERHEADS:

To kill a range of bacteria including Legionella pneumophila:

Soak in a solution of EC9 at a dilution rate of 1:60 warm water for a minimum of 5 minutes. This procedure should be carried out every 3 months.

FLOORS ARE IMPORTANT

A large proportion of dirt entering a building is carried on footwear and if the floors are not correctly cleaned and maintained can suffer damage and potentially create a pathway for cross contamination to occur.

Floors should be cleaned last, with adequate signage placed while the floors are cleaned and left to dry to help prevent slips, trips and falls.

Large and flat surfaces should be cleaned using "S" shape motion, starting at the point furthest away from the door, then overlapping slightly but without going back over the area to avoid recontamination.
